Bar and Off Course

Gentle Reminder to everyone entering the clubhouse please continue to wear a mask when moving around and input your details into track and trace on entry to the bar. It is imperative that these rules are followed for the safety of all our members and staff.

Scott is now back and winter jobs continue to be tackled – another couple of bunkers have been edged and works around the pump house (back of 17th tee) area and around the 8th tee are being tidied up.

This coming week will see works being carried out on bunkers at the 1st and 9th holes. Plan is to raise the bottoms of the existing bunkers above the water table to stop the sand from sitting wet, this will hopefully help the feeling of there being little or no sand in these bunkers. A base layer will then go into the bunkers followed by a teram to stop contamination/weeds and then new sand inserted into bunkers.

Grass will also be stripped from the back of the left hand 10th bunker and re-turfed – this area will become GUR and signed accordingly. Please do not walk over this area.

Any volunteers willing to give some time to assist please contact the club/Scott. All help is greatly appreciated.

We are looking to employ an assistant Greenkeeper and an apprentice Greenkeeper so if any of our members know of anyone who might be interested please get in touch with the club.

Please note that if your ball lands within the marked out winter greens please move your ball to the side no nearer the hole.

Please also ensure that all pitch marks are repaired and if you see another pitch mark on the green please take time to repair this also. To help the greens during these challenging winter conditions we all need to do our bit.
