Thankyou to everyone who took time to respond to the clubs email dated 10th of December on Winter Course options – the high number of responses received was great as it allowed the club to hear the views of as many members as possible.

The majority of members voted for option 2 which was as follows: -

Option 2 – course will remain open if there is a slight frost covering or a light snow covering however, where members safety is at risk in hard frost or heavy snow the course will close. Greens will be on winter greens and will stay on winter greens until such time where conditions improve. Once on winter greens these will not be changed to full greens during the same day due to resources. All play will be on winter greens even if conditions improve during the day.

Small further note to the above is that if the course is on winter greens then Winter League scoring cannot be registered.

Winter works continue to be carried out by Scott and the volunteers with main greens cut and rolled this week along with all winter greens.

We are currently monitoring the 10th green to ensure that it is in the best condition possible ahead of next season. This green does not see the same light as the rest of our greens so is more susceptible to damage during the winter months. Please note that there may be times where this hole is on the winter green while all other holes are on the main greens.

If your ball lands within the marked out winter greens please move your ball to the side no nearer the hole.

Please ensure that all pitch marks are repaired and if you see another pitch mark on the green please take time to repair this also. To help the greens during these challenging winter conditions we all need to do our bit.
